 The wise men seek Jesus (Matthew 2:1-12). Jesus wants us to seek him.

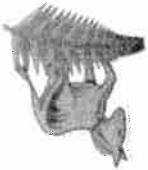
Galilee

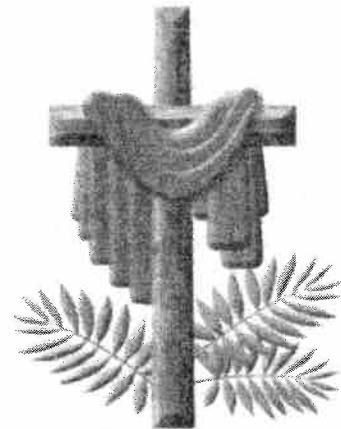


PILGRIM'S PRAYER

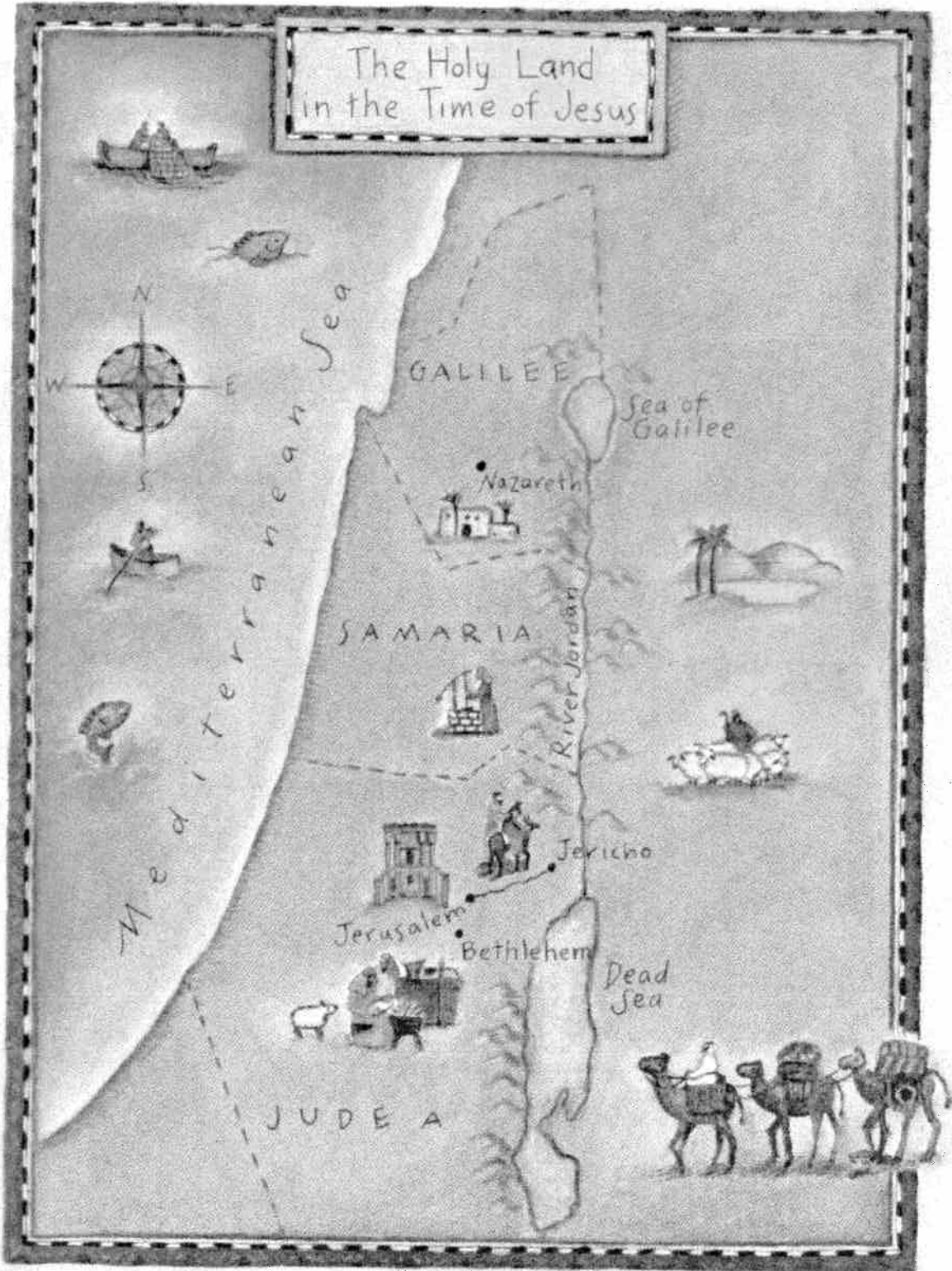
