

After Viewing

1. Do the following activity to reinforce the children's knowledge of the Order of Mass.

Ahead of time, make the following cards:

- 5 cards (5 x 7 inch index cards), all uppercase letters, red marker

Introductory Rites
Liturgy of the Word
Liturgy of the Eucharist
Communion Rite
Concluding Rites

- 34 cards (3 x 5 inch index cards), capitalize the first letter of each word, black marker

Penitential Act	Preface Dialogue

2. Mix up all 39 cards and distribute randomly to the children. Tell them that their task is to arrange the parts of the Mass in order on the board. Prepare 39 small strips of masking tape ahead of time and attach them to the chalk ledge or in a place that is easily accessible.

3. Say: **Let's begin with the five large cards written in red marker. If you have one of those, please come forward.**
4. **These five cards represent the five major parts of the Mass under which we're going to arrange all the other parts. Let's see if you can place them on the board in the correct order.** Direct children to attach the cards to the board in the correct order (as listed on page 26) and as headings for five columns. Assist children until they get the order correct.
5. Next, say: **OK, who thinks they know which of the five categories their card belongs under?** Get a show of hands and begin inviting children to come forward one at a time, attaching cards to the board under the proper heading, but not necessarily in order. Assist children as they do so. Continue until all the cards are in the proper columns. Then invite volunteers to come forward and arrange the cards in the columns in the proper order. Point out that seven of the cards are parts of the Eucharistic Prayer: Preface Dialogue, Preface, Preface Acclamation (or Holy, Holy, Holy), Consecration, The Mystery of Faith, Concluding Doxology, and Amen. The finished chart should look like this. (See the following page.)

*Collect is pronounced KAH-lihkt.
