

Bible Learning Stations – Monday, September 24, 2012

MHR – SOR 6th Grade

1. If possible, please arrive at 6:30 pm so that we can make sure everyone has everything they need:
 - a. 4 learning stations with Bible bookmarks
 - b. Student fill-in sheets
 - c. Bibles
2. As soon as you can enter your room, set up the 4 learning stations on table-tops or desk-tops. Spread them out around the room. Place 4 chairs/desks in front of each learning station.
3. Keep your Bibles and Student fill-in sheets at your “desk” for now
4. Use the time between 7:00 and 7:10 to take attendance, pray, and do any other business you need to complete.
5. We will then proceed with 3 learning sessions:
 - a. Session A: 7:15 – 7:30
 - b. Session B: 7:35 – 7:50
 - c. Session C: 7:55 – 8:10 (note that I have left 5 minutes between each session for a little breathing space!)
6. For each session (beginning with your own students in Session A) direct the students to spread out at the 4 learning stations. For the first session, give each a Bible, a pen/pencil, and a student fill-in sheet and have them write their names on the fill-in sheets. (Subsequent groups will come to you with their Bibles and pens so you only need to give them their fill-in sheet for your learning stations)

7. Tell them they have 3 minutes at each station to fill-in the information on their fill-in sheets and to place their bookmarks in their Bibles.
8. Announce a start time (“Begin!”) and start timing. During the 3 minutes, move from station to station making sure they are on task and inserting their Bible bookmarks in their Bibles in the right place.
9. After 3 minutes, announce “Rotate!” and have them move to the next station, taking with them their Bibles, pens, and fill-in sheets.
10. Repeat this until all the students have completed all 4 learning stations.
11. At the end of each session, send the group to their next room (accompanied by their aide and taking with them their Bibles, pens, and fill-in sheets)
 - a. Joe sends his students to Matt
 - b. Matt sends his students to Russ
 - c. Russ sends his students to Joe
12. For each session, repeat the process (steps 6 through 11, shaded area)
13. By 8:10 you will once again have your own students.
14. Make sure their names are on all their fill-in sheets (they will have one from each session, 3 all together) and COLLECT them to review next class.
15. Have them take their Bible bookmarks out of their Bibles and either take them home and to sit down with their parents and place them in a Bible at home, explaining to them what they learned, OR, you collect them for future use.
16. Gather Bibles and pens/pencils
17. Say a closing prayer and send them on their way.
