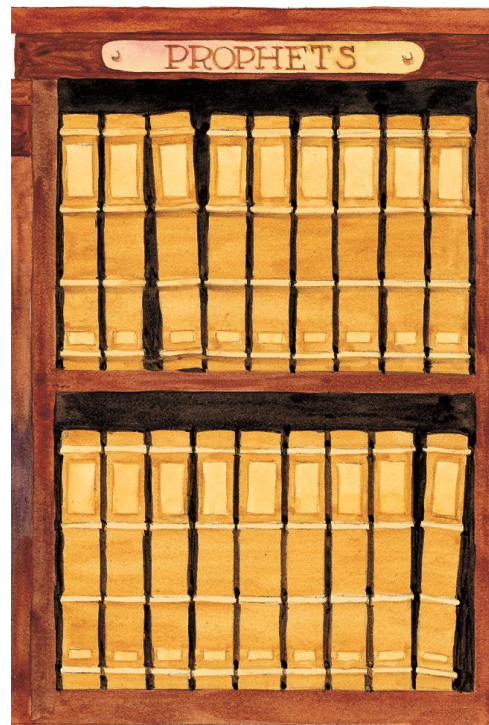




# HIGHLIGHTS:

- **Major Prophets**

- **Isaiah** – “The virgin shall be with child and will give birth to a son and will call him Emmanuel, which means ‘God is with us.’” (Is 7)





- **Jeremiah** – “Ah, Lord, I do not know how to speak. I am too young!” (Jer 1)
- **Ezekiel** – “I will sprinkle clean water on you and you will be clean.” (Ez 36)
- **Daniel** – in the Lion’s Den (Dn 6)



# ● Minor Prophets

- Hosea – “When Israel was a child, I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt.” (Hos 11)



- **Joel** – “Yet, even now, return to me with your whole heart.” (Jl 2)
- **Amos** – “Let justice flow like a river and righteousness like an ever flowing stream.” (Am 5)



- **Jonah** – swallowed by the whale  
(Jon 1)
