
HOW TO BE A MORE EVANGELIZING CATECHIST

These nine strategies are at the heart of the amazingly effective kerygma—the first proclamation of the Gospel by the Apostles.

01	Proclaim an alternate reality to our brokenness.

- 102 Introduce Jesus as Savior.
- O3 Proclaim Jesus' mighty deeds.
- O4 Don't avoid the Cross.
- O5 Proclaim that Jesus is alive!
- O6 Invite, invite, invite!
- 7 Touch the heart.
- Build and deepen commitment.
- Mentor apprentices.
